



< your heart on my sleeve >


An exploration in tactile, aesthetic & emotive computing in the public domain
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“Your heart on my sleeve” visualises responsive data. A persons heart rate is wirelessly communicated to another person. The tactile & highly crafted sleeve demonstrates how contextual information can be explicitly presented to enhance social interaction. The interest in using locative media / situated technologies lies in the potential for shared experience, in this case, data as an aesthetic intervention in the public domain which extends beyond the immediate user / wearer.
