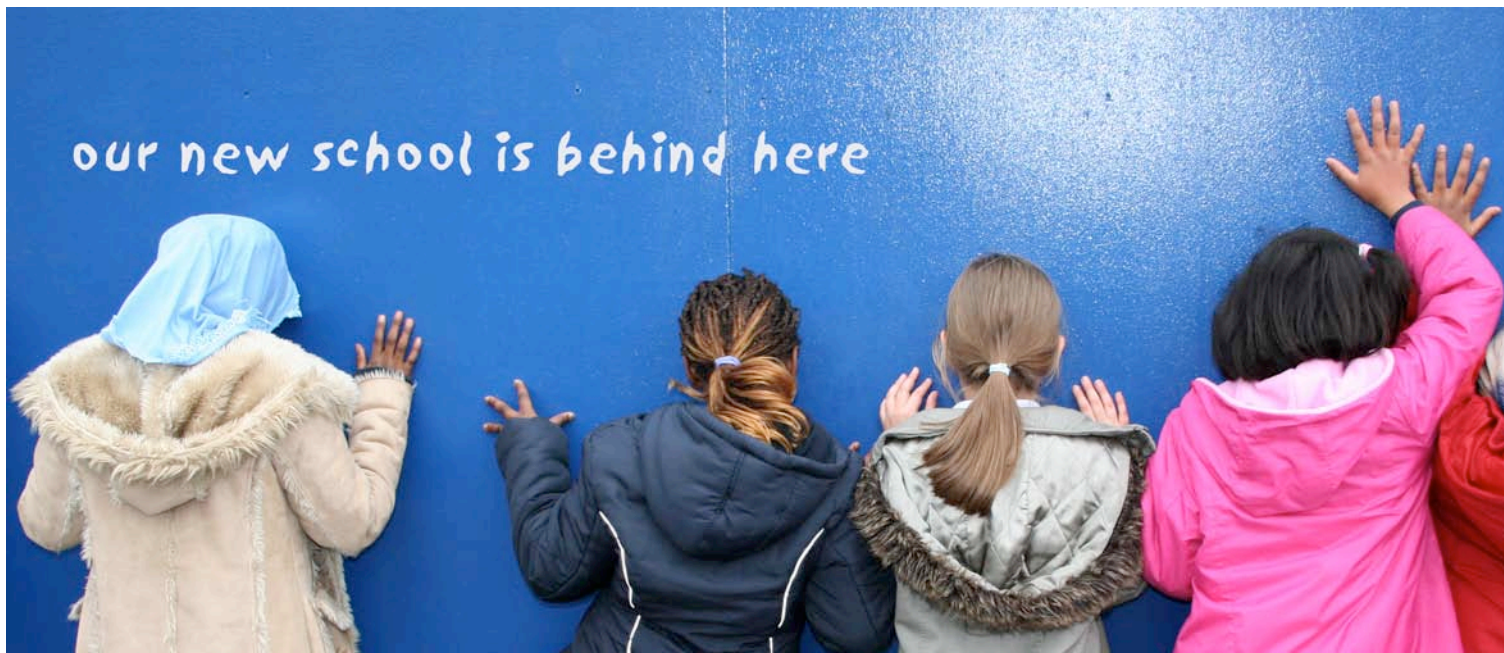

a 'peephole' into the construction site

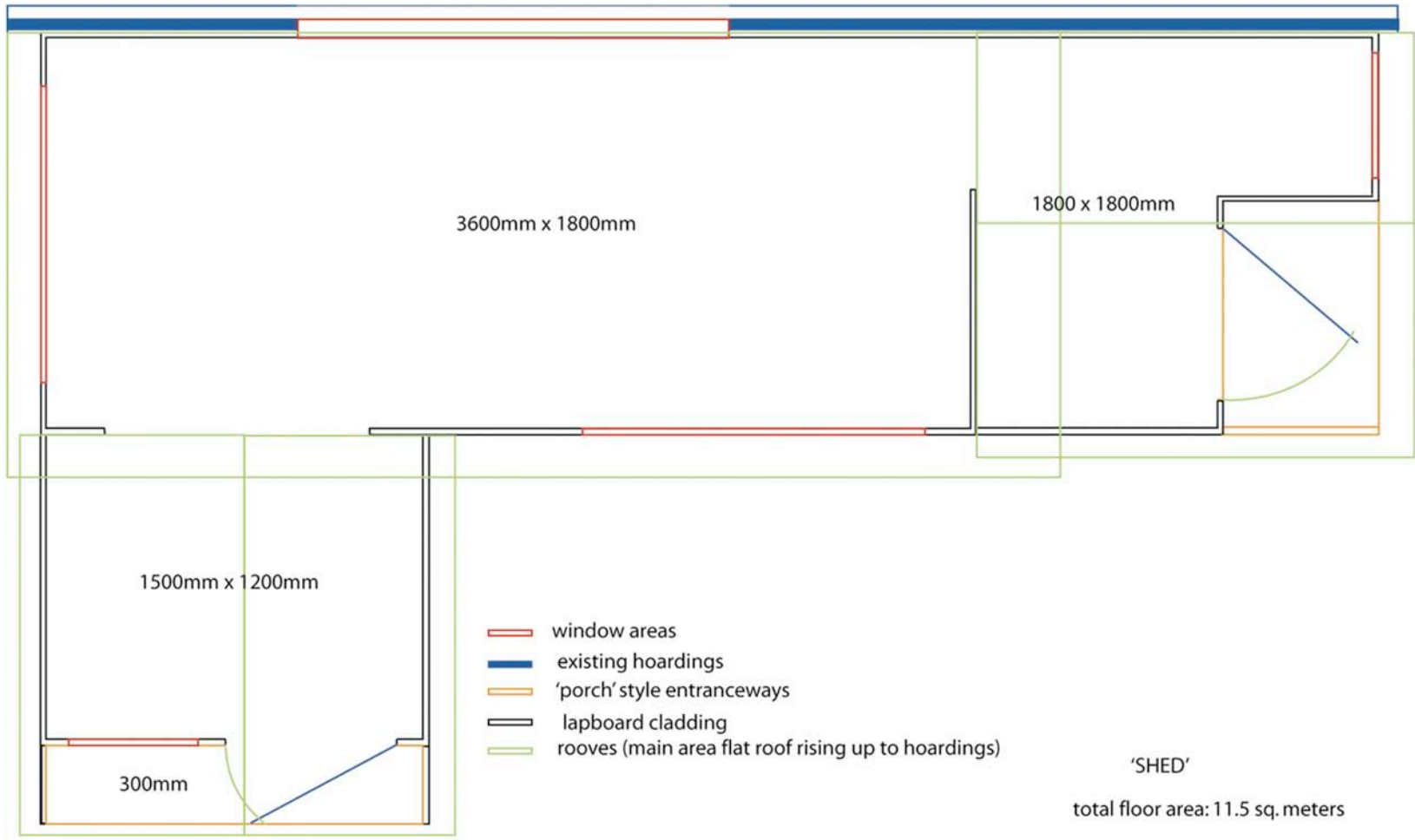

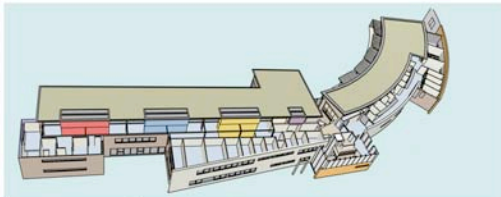
